## Proficiency Exam, Exemption Conditions, and International Language Exam Equivalency Tables

### **Important Notes:**

- 1. Proficiency Exam: An exam administered by the English Preparatory Program at the beginning of the Fall Semester and at the end of the Fall Semester, Spring Semester, and Summer School. This exam is administered to students enrolled in English-medium programs and evaluates their English proficiency. Students who achieve scores equivalent to the ranges shown in Table 1 from this Proficiency Exam or from international exams are exempt from preparatory education (see Table 1). Students who achieve scores equivalent to the ranges shown in Table 2 may also be exempt from the mandatory ENG 121 and ENG 122 courses offered by the Department of Foreign Languages (see Table 2).
- **2. Exemption Exam:** An exam administered by the Modern Languages Unit at the beginning of the Fall Semester for students in Turkish-medium Faculties, Departments, or the Vocational School of Justice (AMYO) for the mandatory courses YBD 109, ENG 109, ENG 110, YBD 209, ENG 209, ENG 210, ING 101, and ING 102 (see Table 3).
- **3.** In accordance with Article 6, Paragraph 2, Clause (d) of the Directive on Determining Foreign Language Exam Equivalencies, for an international foreign language exam to be recognized and maintained as equivalent, if the exam is administered in Turkey, it must be conducted in state universities.
- 4. Results from the TOEFL iBT Home Edition are not accepted.
- **5.** The validity period for the exam results listed below is determined by considering the International Foreign Language Exam Equivalencies Document published by ÖSYM (Student Selection and Placement Center) and relevant exam documentation.
